Roman numerals are read left to right

XIV = 14

X = 10 IV = 4

XLII = 42

XL = 40 II = 2

CCCLXXXIV = 384

CCC = 300 L = 50 XXX = 30 IV = 4

DXCII = 592

D = 500 XC = 90 II = 2

CMXCIX = 999

CM = 900 XC = 90 IX = 9

MCMLXXXVII = 1987

M = 10,000 CM = 9,000 L = 50 XXX = 30 VII = 7
